Grant Line Road - Widening Phase 2



This project widened Grant Line Rd from 2 to 4 lanes, added traffic signals, and added a detached bike line to allow for safe pedestrian and bicycle traffic. We also updated, improved, and extended a culvert system where Elk Grove Creek passes under Grant Line Rd.

We are proud to say that after 76,000 hours of work.. we had no OSHA recordable accidents or near misses on this project! Arterial Roads Rehabilitation and Bicycle Lane Improvements



This project restored Waterman Road and Elk Grove Florin Road and widened them to accommodate bicycles, leading to 4.5 miles of connected bike lanes. Additionally, 20 ADA-compliant curb ramps were added to enhance pedestrian access.
